

DOUBLE DOOR WALL CABINET ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1-

1. Lay one cabinet Left/Right Side Panel (A) on a soft working surface with grooves facing upward. The grooves will be for the Top/Bottom (D) and Back (H) Panels.
2. Insert a Top/Bottom Panel (D) into the grooves on Side Panel (A) making sure clips are lined up and fully engaged. Insert locking screw into clip pair and tighten all screws. Repeat these steps for other Top/Bottom Panel (D).
3. Insert other Side Panel (A) into Top/Bottom Panel (D) making sure clips are lined up and fully engaged. Insert locking screw into each clip pair and tighten all screws.
4. Insert Back Panel (H) into grooves on Side Panel (A) and Top/Bottom Panel (D) making sure clips are lined up and fully engaged. Insert locking screw into clip pair and tighten all screws.*
4. Insert other Side Panel (A) into Top/Bottom Panel (D) and Back Panel (H) making sure clips are lined up and fully engaged. Insert locking screw into each clip pair and tighten all screws.

Step 2 -

1. Attach Front Face (M) onto Top/Bottom Panels (D) and Side Panels (A) making sure panels fit into the grooves of the Front Face (M) and clips are lined up and fully engaged. Insert locking screw into each clip pair and tighten all screws.

Step 3 -

1. From the back of the cabinet, screw the hanging rails for the Back Panel (H) into the Top/Bottom Panels (D).

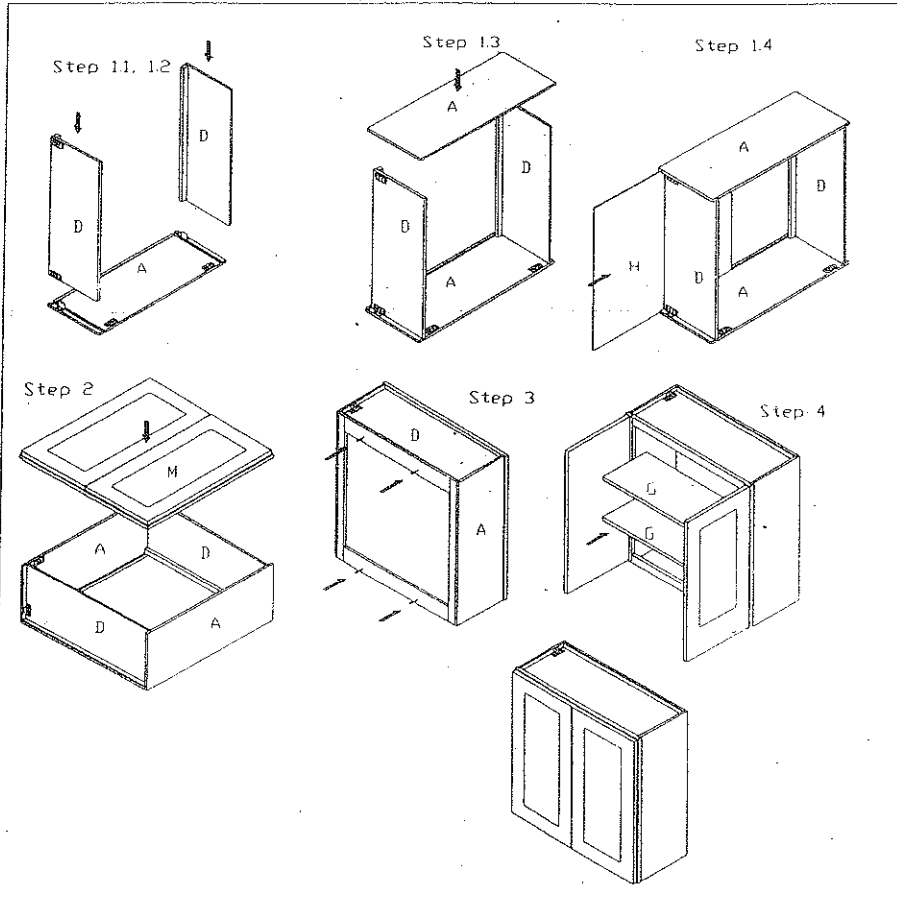
Step 4 -

1. Insert shelf clips into the pre-drilled holes on the Side Panels (A) at desired height and slide in the Shelf (G) making sure the front edge faces out.
